OUR APPROACH & METHODOLOGY

The Single-Source Model

Land planning, landscape architecture, and irrigation design are typically procured as three separate scopes from three separate firms. EDG brings all three disciplines together under one roof, with one project team, one point of contact, and one set of coordinated deliverables. When the land planner, landscape architect, and irrigation consultant are working from the same table, plan revisions move faster, conflicts are caught before they reach the field, and the handoffs that typically slow multi-firm projects down simply do not happen.

This structure delivers measurable advantages to clients:

- Faster project start-up, built on an established understanding of the client's standards and expectations
- Schedule flexibility, supported by a team sized and structured to absorb demanding timelines
- In-depth knowledge of local codes and regulations across diverse jurisdictions nationwide

Land Planning Methodology

All successful projects start with a good plan. EDG's land planning process is designed to give clients an informed, defensible site layout before significant investment is made in downstream design and engineering:

- Research applicable local codes and regulations that may affect site layout
- Conduct a preliminary project meeting with the client to confirm program, constraints, and goals
- Prepare an illustrated conceptual site plan for client review
- Review the conceptual site plan with the client via a live, screen-share working session
- Incorporate the client's comments and revise the conceptual site plan
- Receive the client's final approval on the concept

- Prepare a colored conceptual site plan with a detailed legend, land-use and program summary data, and required calculations

Cost-Conscious Design

Several of EDG's senior leaders bring more than design experience to every project — they bring field experience as landscape contractors. That firsthand knowledge of how a design actually gets built shapes the way EDG approaches every plan. A design isn't finished when it simply looks right; it's finished when it looks right and can be built and maintained within the client's budget. On every project, EDG asks two questions of each design decision: how can this same look and feel be achieved while keeping construction costs down, and how can this same look and feel be maintained while keeping long-term maintenance costs to a minimum. That dual discipline — protecting design intent while controlling cost at both the construction and maintenance stages — is built into EDG's process from the earliest concept sketches through construction documentation.

Sustainability Approach

EDG designs with resource efficiency and long-term site performance in mind. Depending on project goals, sustainability strategies may include planting palettes suited to regional climate and water availability, water-efficient and smart-controlled irrigation systems, alternative water sources such as ponds and cisterns, water capture and reuse systems (including stormwater runoff, HVAC condensate, and greywater), and green roof irrigation. EDG has experience supporting projects pursuing LEED accreditation and preparing MWELC calculations for projects located in California.

Quality Assurance / Quality Control

Every EDG deliverable passes through a structured internal review before it reaches the client, checking for code compliance, internal coordination between planting, hardscape, and irrigation documents, and constructability. Because EDG was founded by a landscape contracting professional, plans are reviewed not only for design intent but for how they will actually be built and maintained — identifying code conflicts, budget concerns, and constructability issues early, and bringing solutions rather than open questions back to the client.

Communication Strategy

EDG's team is intentionally structured to span all four continental U.S. time zones, enabling real-time coordination regardless of a project's location. Clients work directly with licensed professionals and firm principals — not account managers — for faster answers and fewer delays. Technology-enabled collaboration, including remote working sessions and screen-share plan reviews, allows EDG to connect with clients and consultants daily in a cost-effective, schedule-friendly way.

Technology & Visualization

EDG utilizes computer-aided design (CAD) platforms, 3D modeling, and digital rendering tools throughout the design process to help clients and reviewing agencies visualize a project before construction begins, and to coordinate efficiently with civil, architectural, and MEP consultant teams.

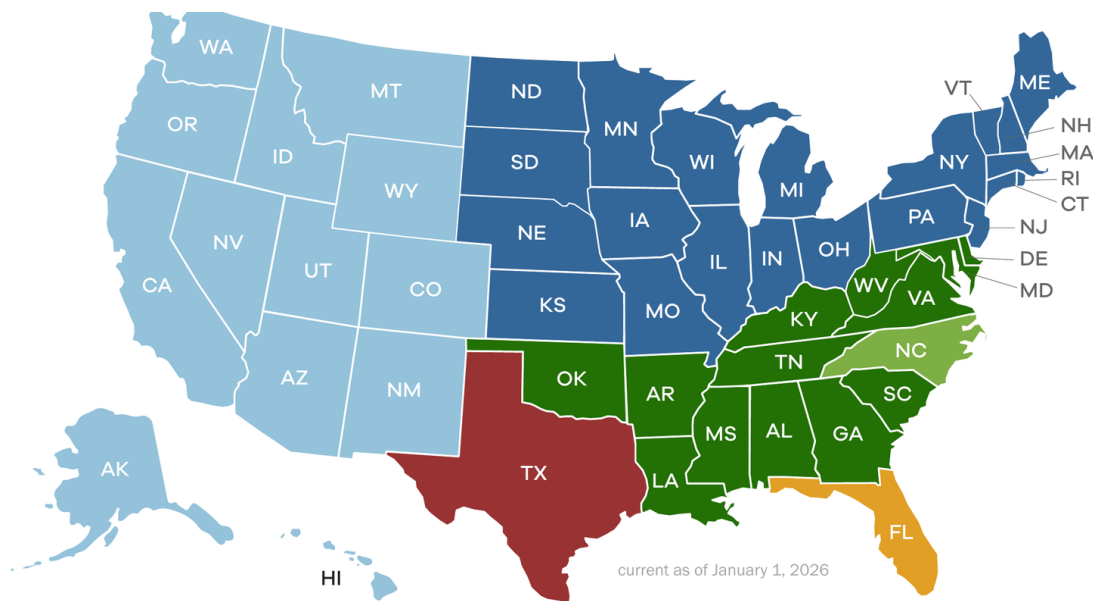

Schedule Management

Project schedules are established at kickoff and tracked against key milestones — concept approval, jurisdictional submittal, permit issuance, and construction document release. EDG's distributed team structure, spanning four U.S. time zones, provides the flexibility to compress review cycles when client schedules demand it.

Budget Control

Cost-consciousness is built into EDG's design process from the conceptual phase forward. Value engineering and cost estimating are incorporated early, and constructability reviews — informed by the firm's landscape contracting background — are used to identify budget risk before it reaches construction documents.

Risk & Quality Management

Every deliverable is reviewed internally for code compliance, cross-discipline coordination (planting, hardscape, and irrigation documents), and constructability prior to client release. Potential code conflicts, budget concerns, and constructability issues are flagged proactively, with EDG bringing recommended solutions to the client rather than leaving problems open-ended.

Coordination with Consultants

EDG regularly integrates with civil engineers, architects, and design-build contractor project teams, adapting to each client's CAD standards, communication protocols, and project management systems. Because land planning, landscape architecture, and irrigation design are handled in-house, EDG functions as a single, coordinated point of contact for the landscape scope within a larger consultant team — reducing the coordination burden on the client's project manager.

Stakeholder & Client Engagement

EDG maintains direct, senior-level engagement throughout each project — clients work with licensed professionals and firm principals rather than intermediary account managers.
